Happy Mother's Day! I was lucky growing up because I knew at a very early age how important my mother was to me. She was a very loving person to everybody but especially to us children and although I couldn't express it, I knew how important it was to me. When I was two years old my mother's older sister died as a result of surgery leaving behind six children the youngest being also two years of age. I didn't know what it was like for him to not have a mother, but I knew what it was like for me to have one and was convicted to make sure that he didn't miss out on the good things having a mother meant to me. To make sure of this I often asked my mother to bring him to do fun things with us.

I must admit that I was surprised that when I told him I was going into the seminary, he sat down and went over all the things that I did for him when he was growing up. He remembered things that I had long forgotten about. I know it sounds strange, but I felt like a mother at that moment. I realized that I have been very fortunate in my life as not only have I had a birth mother, but I've also had lots of other mothers along the way. My aunt Helen who lived next door served as the backup mom to me if I wanted a second opinion on something. She always took my side. A friend of the family who had five children over on also used her mothering on me to teach me many things most of all respect. My sisters, while I had no use for them as a child, took on a mothering role to me as I grew up. Thus, I have been reminded that we are all called to show that love, compassion and support for each other whether we are biologically a mother or even biologically a woman!

When I look to Jesus, I see the love he showed to everyone especially to his own children, his disciples. He never gave up on them always allowed them to start over again and assured them of his love no matter what. God the father sent him to us to be an example not only of his love for us but the love we are called to show to one another. Let me use this Mother's Day as an example to you how I've tried to love you. I have tried to show a mother's love, although I'm sure I don't love as well as my own mother did, and I am proud to see where the parish has come and where it is going.

If you've learned anything from me, let it be the love and care, but I have tried to show as an example to you that you may show that same love and care to each other, especially when it's difficult. My mother always forgave, Jesus always forgave, and the love we are called to show should remind us that we are called to forgive and to love as moms.
