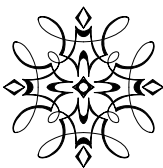

The Pastor's Corner

Happy Feast of Joan of Arc to all! We will be celebrating today in the parking area and in the parish hall with many activities for the children, and adults who are given permission today to be childlike as you enjoy the fun. Thank you to all the volunteers who are preparing the food and venue to make it a great day. God Bless you all! Congratulations to James Hogan and to Philippa Sheppard-Oppel who will receive the Joan of Arc Award to day for their dedicated service to the parish and its ministries. We are grateful to the many stewards of our ministries, but these two individuals are recognized this year for the extraordinary gifts they bring to serve the parish. Thank you to each of you and May God fill you with choicest blessings.

It's Trinity Sunday. We begin our worship: "In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." This opening to our prayers gives witness to our Faith in the Blessed Trinity, three persons in the One God. It is so simply a part of our faith awareness that we barely pay attention to what it means for us. Yet it is a marvelous mystery, in which we live and move and have our being. It is far beyond our human capacity to fully understand it has helped us to appreciate the wonder of God. The revelation of this mystery unfolded in Salvation history and was only fully revealed in the Gospel remembrances

Trinity at the Baptism of the Lord, and in the Command that all the world be baptized in the Holy Name of the Trinity helps us to realize God's intimate relationship with us. This mystery helps us to see that we are created, redeemed and made holy by God who has made us for the Glory of Salvation. The relationship of the three persons in the Trinity is a dynamic into which we are born ourselves through baptism as daughters and sons of God.

This week the Ministries committee gathered on Tuesday and began the discernment of bringing on another pastoral associate to assist us in our parish ministries. This committee is designed to identify our ministerial needs and then to find ways to meet these. We are deeply grateful to the dedicated members of this group who support the parish and me in many ways.

This week there was also a gathering of the parish Family of Faith Committee who will be working with the Archdiocesan representatives to assist us in the administration of the Family of Faith Capital Campaign effort over the next several weeks, and into the early autumn. This campaign has a goal to raise \$105,000.000 to build the life and future of the Church of the Archdiocese. More information on our own parish goal and the manner in which we will proceed with this will be forthcoming in the next couple of weeks. Please be generous in this campaign.

I became aware that there were not enough yearend financial statements inserted in the bulletin last week, so we have made some available in the back of the church. If you have any questions about this please feel free to ask members of the Finance Committee who will be available at the Annual General Meeting in the parish hall on June 2.

Happy Joan of Arc Day everyone and my God continue to bless our parish with abundant life and vitality as we continue to fulfill the mission to Live and Proclaim the Gospel through Stewardship and welcoming all to know and worship the Lord.
