

THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Peace and Goodness to all!

Jesus tells us, "I am the vine, you are the branches. Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit, because without me you can do nothing." These words encourage us to remain faithfully grounded in the Lord as the source of our life and strength. As a parish dedicated to Christian Stewardship these words provide a vision for our sustenance and direction for our growth as we serve the Mission of the Church.

Last week, 21 of our children received their First Holy Communion. We are grateful for faithful dedication and love of the parents and teachers who prepared these children to receive this Blessed Sacrament. Truly they are instruments of the Lord who prepared them to be grafted to the Vine who is Christ. We pray they may have lives that are deeply rooted in the Love of God who is the source of all life in abundance. We give thanks to God for this blessing and new life. There are so many ways that our parishioners share their life and gifts for us every week. Much of their work goes unnoticed, but without their services we could not continue to serve. The Golden Girls gather weekly to prepare the deposit of the collection. At the same time the Scribes, write letters for me to sign for newly registered parishioners, persons who are ill or individuals who are mourning the death of a loved one. Sometimes it is a congratulatory note to a couple celebrating an anniversary, or a word of hope to someone who needs encouragement. How grateful I am to these persons who serve the parish faithfully behind the scenes every week. Actually, there are sixteen different groups and committees that continue the work of our parish, and all of them demonstrate the many branches of the fruitful Vine that is Christ. This week, on Tuesday, the feast of St Joseph the worker, the building

maintenance committee gathered with a full agenda to continue with the projects to improve our worship space, secure our facilities and to plan the Parish Cleanup day on Saturday. They along with the Gardening Committee worked tirelessly on Saturday to maintain and beautify our surroundings. The work of these individuals, demonstrate the life of Christ serving to build our Community of faith and love.

On Wednesday we had the telephone system updated. The system was more than 20 years old and needed repair, we hope it will meet our needs. We are also in the slow process of improving our computer and website so that our communication facilities can serve more effectively.

At the staff meeting on Wednesday we discussed the ongoing need to grow our staff to meet the pastoral needs of the parish. Our Parish Ministries Committee is also working on creating the tools that will help the whole parish to identify our needs and meet them effectively.

The Finance committee has completed the annual financial report and we hope to present this to the parish in the next couple of weeks. We are grateful to the members of this committee which is also initiating new members in the ordinary rotation process. The many ways that our parishioners serve the spiritual and temporal needs of the parish inspire me with gratitude to God who gives us so much life and grace to serve this Vine rooted in Christ. Indeed it is one which the Lord has planted. Thank you all for your prayerful and dedicated service in the parish.
