The Pastor's Corner Peace and Goodness to All!

Happy Mothers day to all of our wonderful Mothers, Grandmothers and Great-Grandmothers. May God Bless them and the many people in our lives who have been like mothers to us in their care and nurturing spirits. You have blessed us with the life and care that has made us who we are. This is a day we all celebrate with gratitude and appreciation for the love and dedication that our mothers have demonstrated so constantly in our lives. May God bless each and every one of you and your loved ones on this annual occasion for us to say Thank you to all of you for you for the life and love that you have so generously given.

It is also the feast of the Ascension of the Lord, today we remember that Jesus ascended to be seated at the right hand of the Father to intercede for us in all our needs. This feast points us toward Pentecost which is celebrated next week and will be the end of the Easter Season. This is a particularly holy time for the Church when we realize that God provides for our every need in his love and presence.
