The Pastor's Corner Peace and Goodness to All!

This week I have been involved with the General Council meetings of the Atonement Friars here at Graymoor. Part of our discussions have involved the upcoming visit of the Minister General and a few of the Friars planned for Nov. 1. They are looking forward to meeting with the parishioners of St. Joan of Arc Parish. Fr. Brian Terry a former associate and current Minister General of the Friars, will be the keynote speaker at our semi-annual ministries retreat. He will talk about the mission of the Friars and its impact on our parish ministries. The great parallel between the Spirit of Stewardship and the charism of the Friars is clear and so it lends itself to enhancing our life as an Atonement Friar ministry. Cyndy O'Grady has sent the invitations to all of our leaders and ministers and so we are looking forward to hosting the Friars during their visitation and listening to Fr. Brian as he addresses the important contributions to the life of the Church that are made through our parish. I encourage all who are invited to come and participate in this day of prayer and presentation.

Fr. Paul Wattson, SA, the founder of the Atonement Friars instituted what he called the U.N.B.L. principal. This was based on the passage from John's gospel story of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes for the multitudes, when Jesus instructed his disciples to "gather up the fragments that nothing be lost." From this Fr. Paul composed a prayer which reads: Lord Jesus Christ you commanded your disciples to gather up the fragments that nothing be lost. Give us the grace to waste nothing, but to use all our time talents substance and opportunities for the glory of God the good of our neighbor and the salvation of all,... This prayer addresses all of the values of the Stewardship prayer which is recited before all of our Sunday masses, to inspire the way we operate our parish ministries. Fr. Brian continues as the minister general in succession of Fr. Paul's leadership to inspire us to continue the work of the Lord Jesus in our life as a parish. As we use and contribute our time talents and material possessions in making Stewardship a way of life, we demonstrate the U.N.B.L. Principles that are a part of the friars tradition. Indeed we keep these principals alive in all that we are and do.

I am deeply grateful to all of you who make St. Joan of Arc parish the dynamic place it is and it will be a joy to have Fr. Brian and the Friars here to celebrate the special visitation time to come in the near future. May the Lord multiply the work of our hands and hearts in all things.


