## Society of St. Vincent de Paul

Mission Statement: "To Live the Gospel message by serving Christ in the poor with love, respect, justice and joy."

The Society was formed in 1833, when Frederic Ozanam and a group of students from Sorbonne University were challenged to prove their faith in Christ through action, not just words. They accepted the challenge and the society was formed to work with the desperately poor in Paris, France.

This work is continued today worldwide, following their example in small working groups known as conferences. A conference is parish based, such as St. Joan of Arc's Conference. The parish based Vincentians are the fundamental part of the organization and are the ones that serve those in need through person to person contact.

Conferences that have more money than they need send funds downtown to help run our homes in the city and support the other projects of the society such as the prison ministry

### What do we do?

We send children camp in the summer for one week, who otherwise would not be able have a vacation outside of the city.

We give out Christmas hampers to the needy families in our area with your help. The Christmas Hamper envelopes and the St. Nicholas toy drive, make up the help we are able to distribute to the less fortunate of our community.

We hold Bundle Weekends, such as the one booked for November 19-20. To collect gently used clothing and small household items. These items go to our warehouse and store and our clients can go with the vouchers we issue them and purchase the items they need for their homes.

We make monthly visits to our clients when the call in for help. Most are looking for help with food, but occasionally they will need a clothing voucher. For those who live farther away from the grocery store, we will supply 2 TTC tokens so they are able to get there and back home with their groceries.

We tell our clients that we are accountable to you the parishioners of St. Joan of Arc, for the money we take in and spend on them.

The voucher bill that comes in at the end of each month and we keep it paid up as much as possible. At the moment our bills from the store are increasing and our donations are dropping. We would like to thank those who continue to support us by way of our poor box.

We would like to remind you if you use our blue St Vincent de Paul envelopes, that we will issue you a tax receipt at the end of the year.
