

#### THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Peace and Goodness to all!

This week I have been attending the annual priest seminar for the Archdiocese of Toronto here at Nottawasaga Inn. The topic is "Theology in the Parish – Does it Matter." For three days we have been engaged with theologians from St. Augustine Seminary who are presenting material from a broad range of topics to give us a review of current trends in theology as it is being taught in the Archdiocesan seminary. We began with important ideas from Systematic Theology, which are having a real effect on the development of the Church today. We then looked at Liturgical nuances to help us improve our celebrations in light of the changes in the Roman Missal. Perhaps my favorite was a look at "What is happening in Scripture Study Now". It was encouraging to see that the scripture study course we present on Wed. evenings here at St. Joan of Arc employ the tools and patterns we were presented. We also looked at the character of healthy sexuality and sacrament of Marriage which is a crucial topic for the future of the Church. We concluded with a projected vision of the Church and theology for the next hundred years.

The ongoing formation for our life and faith as priests is an important value in our ministry and I have deeply appreciated the opportunity that has been given us through this annual seminar. Our focus is always concentrated on improving our service to you the parishioners so that your and faith may be nourished and your life in Christ may be enhanced through participation in the Church. We are deeply blessed as a parish as we engage in the stewardship of the various ministries which contribute so richly to the cooperative inter-action of our many parts to the whole parish. In our first parish retreat last year we focused on "The Eucharist as the Source and Summit of the life of the Church" inviting all to reflect on how the ministries we engage in draw from the Liturgy and contribute to the Eucharistic worship that is the center of our life as a parish. This theme has been re-affirmed throughout this seminar and is an affirmation that we are moving in the right direction in our parish development. Our parish ministries committee continues to work toward realizing this focus as we continue the mission of the Church, to proclaim the Good news of Jesus Christ in our community.

Thank you to all of your for your lively participation in the life and worship of the Parish, may the Holy Spirit continue to guide and empower us to fulfill this sacred mission to grow our relationships with God and one another in Christ.
