Welcome, Brother Alexander!

At last, I'm not alone. Last week I picked up Brother Alexander, our new deacon, from the airport and his dog Aluen (pronounced *ă loo' en*). She's a sweet mini-Labrador, about 10 years old. Her name comes from an extinct Patagonian language meaning "light of the moon". She's a little on the shy side, but then again so was Sonya, and I told her that her job is to teach Bodie some manners. He seems to be happy to have a friend living with him.

Speaking of Bodhi, you've probably noticed that I've had to take him out of Masses because of his bad behavior. He always looks very penitent afterwards, but he needs to learn to behave. So, I may be signing him up for obedience classes. Lately, it hasn't been just at Mass but at meetings where he thinks I'm there to entertain him and he's constantly putting his paw on me or grabbing my shirt and trying to pull me out of the chair simply to go outside and look around. I tell him I'm not here to keep him occupied but I have work to do but he doesn't seem to care. So, we're working on this.

We are continuing to gear up here at the parish so don't think we've forgotten about you. Many of you who signed up to be involved in ministries will have to go through clearance by the diocese and there is a load of paperwork to be done, but we're working on it. We'll soon be starting up our young adult ministry and hoping that we can find some leaders and some youth to rekindle our youth ministry after COVID. Also, we have a new team working on the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) and hopefully that will be starting up again this week. If you know of anyone interested in becoming Catholic, or even curious about Catholicism even if they don't wish to become Catholic, have them get in touch with us. If you have already been in touch with us about this and haven't heard back from us either this week or next, please contact us again so that we can get you into the program. I am grateful that we have had people step up to continue this ministry at the parish and in diocese since many parishes don't do this and they send their people to us!

This week we will have, for the first time, a special Mass for All Souls. The Parishioner Support Ministry will be collecting and reading out the names of parishioner's families and friends who have died in the past year and there will be a memory wall in the parish hall. After the Mass there will be a reception hosted by the Merrymakers Ministry. I am pleased to see our ministries working together to service the parish community.

I hope to see us continue to grow together as one Church family.


