#### The Pastor's Corner

Peace and Goodness to All!

We welcome Rosanne home from her time in Europe. It isn't often that Rosanne goes away. While we always appreciate her dedication to the parish, it is when she is away, that we truly appreciate all that she is and does for the life and organization of the parish. Let us pray for her and her family in thanksgiving for the gifts she and John bring to our parish.

This week I have been at Graymoor for meetings. We on the General Council have been engaged with the senior leaders of the Atonement Friars community in a series of exercises to update our Vision and Mission Statements and to clearly articulate our Values as a Community. It has been an intensive set of meetings that have helped us to re-focus on our core mission values that help us to sustain our vision as a community whose charism for the Church is the At-one-ment of all creation with God and people with one another. Our own mission statement at St. Joan of Arc which is articulated: Proclaiming and Living the Gospel through Stewardship, All are Welcome is an extension of the Atonement Friars Mission. The particular goals and objectives of our parish are formulated from our parish mission as directed through the Ministries Committee and other organs of our parish administration. When we complete our efforts here at Graymoor, I will be able to bring forth the fruit of our work to the parish so it will influence the ongoing life and vitality of this local community. Thank you all for your prayers in our efforts, they have been deeply appreciated.

The building committee met on Tuesday night and kept in touch with me by email to let me know that they have recommended a company to assess the work that will need to be done for the repair and maintenance of our stained glass windows. The church is close to 60 years old and so it is important for us to do the necessary work that will keep the building sound and in good repair for the next generations. The building committee has already prepared a 30 year maintenance projection for ordinary repairs and upkeep, but the assessments that the building committee proposes will go into more detail with professional window and building 'envelope' experts to see the scope of work that is necessary and discover the costs and time frames that will be involved in the processes. "If the Lord does not build the house then in vain do the builders labour" this line from Psalm 127 inspires our Building committee and we always look to St. Joseph to guide the work of our hearts and hands.

Vivian Kwok has continued to accept registrations to our Religious Education Programs. She has done a great work of recruiting and training our teachers and assistants. It was a joy to commission this team last Sunday to continue the important ministry of teaching our children to know love and serve the Lord Jesus. The preparations for the reception of the Sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation are an important part of this. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Children, is also a program from the religious education office. for those who are over 7 years of Age who have not been baptized. This program works in tandem with the RCIA Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults that prepares individuals who are interested in becoming Catholics either through baptism or reception into full communion with the Catholic Church. We will continue to accept new inquirers to the RCIC and RCIA

programs in the coming weeks. Please contact the office if you are interested.

Last Sunday, we blessed the harvest from the interfaith garden that is situated in the shared back yards of Redeemer Lutheran Church and St. Joan of Arc. The produce is shared with many of the outreach centers that provide meals and hospitality to those in need. It is a shared grass roots ecumenical and interfaith effort that touches the lives of many of God's people. Today we will celebrate the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi with the blessing of the animals. Please bring your beloved pets in at 2:00 PM for this annual celebration of life that is manifest in all God's creatures great and small.

As ever it has been a blessed week with life in abundance for all of us to share and give thanks to God. Thank you all for your participation in the ministries and life of the parish.




