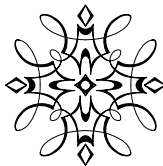

Welcome back all who have been on holiday or at the cottage. Welcome back to the Choirs and the various committees, ministries and stewards of life and activities here at St. Joan of Arc. It is a joy to begin another vibrant season.

It has not been a slow summer for us here with weddings, funerals and the ordinary liturgical life ongoing in season and out of season, as we are called to live and proclaim the gospel.

No doubt, you have all seen the scaffolding around the tower and the upper portions of the Church as the brickwork is being refurbished. The dust was so high that at one point the fire department came to answer a call because someone thought the dust was smoke from a fire! This work has been overseen throughout the summer by our building committee. We are so grateful to Barry Carolyn and Tom Fijalkowski for their leadership in this effort. At one point, Fr. Dan was invited to don a pair of steel tipped shoes to inspect the tower and view the bell at the top. The bell dates back to 1891 and was originally installed at St. Bridget's Church in Ottawa and was brought here when our new Church was built in the late 60s. Saving the tower and the bell has become the project for which the "Iron friar" will be running the Lake Placid Ironman 70.3 to once again raise funds for a tangible purpose improving our Church. For the past 10 years the Iron friar funds have been dedicated to renovations and improvements that are annually identified and completed. We have fixed the stained-glass windows, fixed the air conditioning, installed a carillon, renovated the hall washrooms, installed new carpeting fixed the boiler, renovated the meeting room storage cabinets, and done other improvements all from your generosity to this annual campaign. This year, the restoration of the tower, the bell and fixing the stained glass and metal doors will be accomplished through the funds raised in this effort. Fr. Dan completed the Tupper Lake Tinman race in June and will run the Ironman 70.3 race on September 8 in Lake Placid NY. We are grateful for your donations to this project. Donation envelopes are in the back of the Church. Cheques can be made out to St. Joan of Arc parish. Fr. Dan will hopefully bring his medal to show on Sunday September 15, and he is grateful for your prayerful support in this event.

As the year progresses, our efforts at revitalizing the parish through our dedication to Gospel Stewardship will be guided by our Ministries committee and we are grateful to Les Muniak and Cathi Richardson for their leadership in this endeavor. The annual Stewardship weekend event will be modified, as the plans will out line and we will keep you all informed of this as the season progresses.

Because our 100th Jubilee celebrations happened to celebrate St. Joan of Arc day last May, we did not have the opportunity to present the Joan of Arc Awards at that time and so on the 15th of September we will celebrate the services of Lyette Obonsawin, for her service on the Ministries Committee, Les Muniak for his service in Ministries and Stewardship and Ivan Kastelic for his generous service in our building committee. We are so grateful to these three individuals whose generosity of service to the parish community makes a positive difference in all that we are and do as a parish. Thank you to them and to all of our generous parishioners who dedicate their lives, time talents and services to make St. Joan of Arc the vibrant parish God helps us to be. It is a joy to serve as your pastors as together we live and proclaim the Gospel through Stewardship and welcome all to know, love and serve the Lord.
