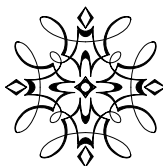

Welcome home to all of you who have been at the Cottage or on holidays over the summer. It is good to have the bulletin back on line as we begin a new academic year. For those of you who were not here when Fr. Mon arrived, we welcomed Fr. Raymond Luis SA as a new member of our parish team. Fr. Mon was appointed by the Archbishop as pastoral associate here at St. Joan of Arc. He will be a great addition to our staff. Already he has been a regular part of our Mass celebration schedule and is becoming integrated to the community activities.

Last evening the Ministries committee met to discuss our plans for the coming year. Top of the agenda was the initiative to plan and implement a new parish survey to assess our Spiritual, Social and Service needs and consider how best to meet these as we continue our mission of Living and proclaiming the Gospel and welcoming all to our parish community.
