MISSION STATEMENT: TO LIVE THE GOSPEL MESSAGE BY: "SERVING CHRIST, IN THE POOR WITH LOVE, RESPECT, JUSTICE AND JOY"

We are part of a worldwide organization founded in 1833. We are the grass roots, at the parish level who deal directly with the poor. AS you go up the ladder, there is the Archdiocesan level; Provincial; National and International levels of the Society.

What do we do?

We help families with food vouchers six months of the year. So, every second month they can ask for assistance from the society. We send children to camp in the summer for one week, who otherwise would not be able to have a vacation outside of the city. We give out Christmas hampers, to the needy families in our area with your help. The Christmas Hamper envelopes and the toy drive the parish holds each year, make up the hampers that we give out each year. During the pandemic, we were unable to give out Christmas gifts to our clients, and the funds were down so we were limited to what we could give out.

We hold bundle weekends, twice a year, to support our store and warehouse. (Next one is November 19-20). We give out clothing vouchers to clients, and they can shop at the warehouse store. Once Covid is completely over, we will resume home visits. During the time of Covid, we were unable to make home visits, so we mailed out vouchers, so they would not go hungry.

We have told our clients we are accountable to you the parishioners of St. Joan of Arc, for what you give us and how and why we give out the help. The bill comes in once a month from Fresh-Co. The money collected in the poor box, pays the bill. Unfortunately, the bills have gone up and the money coming in has gone down. And we have had to ask for help from the next level of St. Vincent de Paul a couple of times this year.

We would like to ask you to consider giving to the poor box, by way of loose change or using our blue envelopes with your information on the outside, so we can issue tax receipts at the end of the year. We accept cash and cheques payable to the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, (Blue envelopes are at the entrance of the church.)

We thank those who continue to support us with their donations. Without your support, we could not continue to serve the marginalized of our community.
