The Society of St. Vincent de Paul St. Joan of Arc Conference

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul started in 1833 when Frederic Ozamam and a group of students from Sorbonne University were challenged to prove their faith in Christ through action, not just words. They accepted the Challenge, and the Society was formed, working with the desperately poor in Paris.

The Conference here at St. Joan of Arc was started and received its *Letter of Aggregation*, July 17, 1989, and have continued the challenge since then. We have been assisting the less fortunate, with emergency help with food, clothing and furniture vouchers, thanks to the financial support we get from you the parishioners.

Covid 19 has been hard on our clients, and we have not been able to make the usual home visits. We continue to help our clients, by mailing out the food vouchers to them. We have found our list of clients has been increasing, since so many people have been laid off or lost their jobs completely. But our donations have dropped due to Covid-19. When you give to the poor box, you help us to carry on this great work of charity. If you use our blue envelopes, we will issue tax receipts at the end of the year. Each level of the society sends any surplus funds up to the next level, and in return if a level needs help, the level above will support the level below with funds.

Each conference tries to hold Bundle Weekends twice a year, to help keep our warehouse supplied with clothing and other necessities. Our next Bundle Weekend is planned for *November 21, 2021*. Unfortunately during the lock down many bundle weekends were cancelled across the city.

The Society has different levels of operation: we are the grassroots or the foundation where the assistance is giving directly to the clients. Particular Councils are the combination of parish conferences in a particular area. We belong to Toronto West Particular Council, where we can go for help or advice. The Archdiocesan Council is made up of all the conferences in the Archdiocese of Toronto. The next level is the Provincial Council and then the National which belongs to the Worldwide Organization.

St. Vincent de Paul has other ways of helping neighbours in need. Such as our group homes: Women's Emergency shelters, the Transition homes, the Prison Apostolate and Court Services. We have a home for people with mental illness who are unable to look after themselves. We have homes to help men and women recover from addictions or released from detox centers. We also, have a home for women who are developmentally handicapped.

On behalf of our members and the neighbours that we help, through the Society of St. Vincent the Paul St. Joan of Arc Conference, I thank you for your continued prayers and financial support. God Bless You!


The 10 am mass is still being live streamed am Mass on Sunday Mornings, Due to some technical problems, mass will be recorded and also saved on Facebook.


