

Thank you to Rose DiTommaso who has worked diligently to prepare the booths and ensure that the necessary follow-up is done to contact individuals who sign up for the various ministries.

Stewardship is major theme and project for our parish, a vital part of our life and work together. All of our parish ministries require your generous participation.
