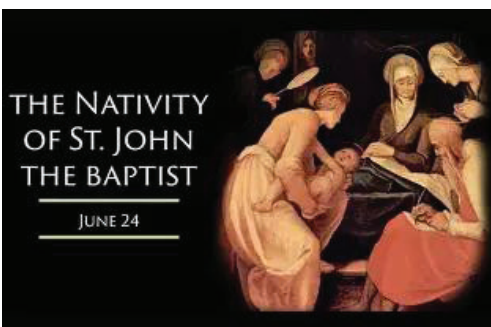

Visit HelpNotHarmCanada.ca where you can e-mail your MP, asking for their support of Bill C-218, which would amend the Criminal Code to prevent Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD) from being provided when mental illness is the sole underlying condition. Without this change, MAiD will be available for those suffering from mental illness alone beginning in March 2027. As Catholics and Canadians, we are called to offer care, hope, and protection — not death — to those who are suffering and most vulnerable. 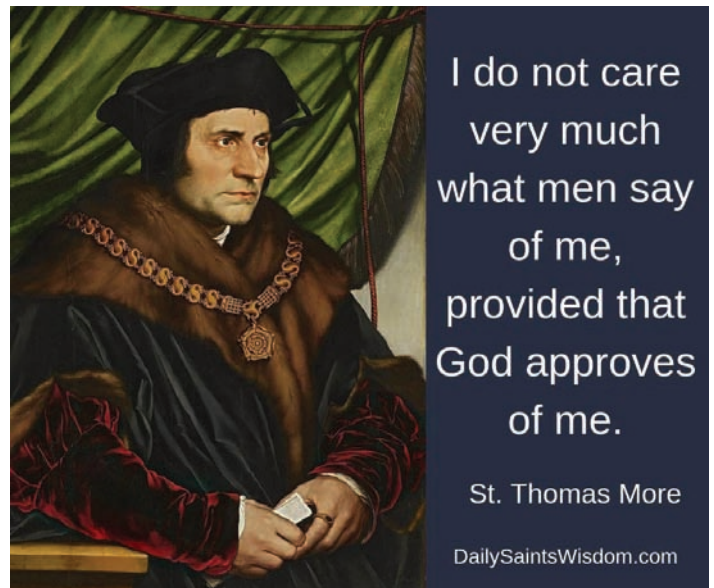
A BIG THANK YOU

also grateful to everyone who donated, brought food to share, and contributed in so many ways to make the day so special. Your generosity, fellowship, and community spirit are greatly appreciated!

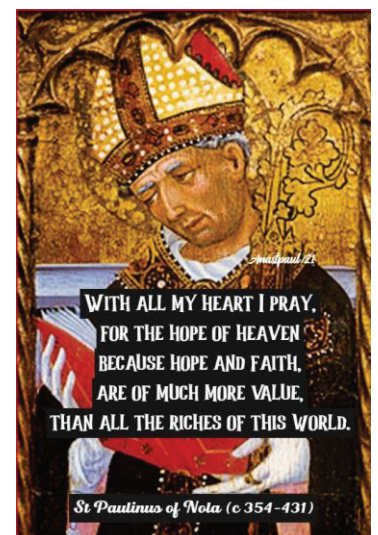
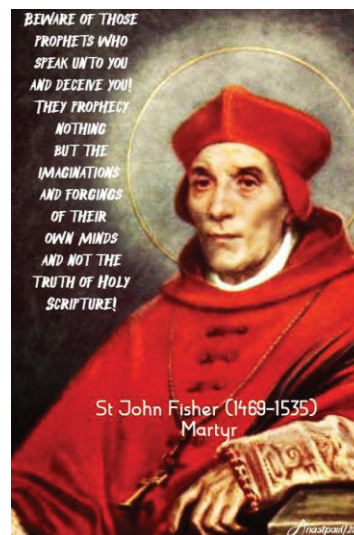
SPECIAL THANKS
