CALL FOR CONSCIENCE CAMPAIGN: UPDATE February 6 – March 31, 2017

More than 25,000 letters have been sent to MPPs. Thank you to all who have written.

After second reading of Bill 84, it went to committee hearings. The first was held March 23 at Queen's Park. Sixteen of the 21 interveners were supportive of including conscience protection in the bill. The interveners included a number of doctors and nurses as well as Cardinal Collins, Bishop Fabbro (as President of the Assembly of Catholic Bishops of Ontario) and Dr. Moira McQueen of the Canadian Catholic Bioethics Institute. A second set of committee hearings took place on March 30. The bill is scheduled to go "clause by clause" on April 11. This is where any amendments will be introduced and voted on by members of the committee. If a conscience amendment is accepted, it will be included in third reading of the bill after which point, members of the legislature vote on the bill. The Liberals have a majority on the committee (and in the legislature) and so far have not indicated their formal support of a conscience amendment. The Conservatives have indicated they will table an amendment on conscience and the NDP has expressed interest in supporting the amendment but have not made a firm commitment.

On March 27, an open letter to all MPPs was sent by 9 Christian, Jewish and Muslim faith leaders.

Pray for the campaign, those who seek assisted suicide and for health care.
