



This year we celebrate the 400th anniversary of the canonization of the "Five Saints" —Saints Philip Neri, Ignatius of Loyola, Francis Xavier, Teresa of Avila, and Isodore the Farmer. It was an important celebration of the spiritual fruitfulness of the Catholic Counter-Reformation. The anniversary gives us the opportunity to reflect on the idea of sanctity and the powerful example that the saints give us, the Church's beginning to recognize various Christians as saints in the liturgy, and the canonical process of canonization the Church developed. Saint Philip was convinced that Catholics should give more attention to lives of the saints—reading books that begin with the letter "S", like Saint Augustine, Saint Benedict, etc.

Lectures will be at 8:30 a.m., 11:00 a.m., and 1:15 p.m. EST, with Mass at 10:00 a.m. Lunch is provided for those attending in person. **The course will be available in person and online**. For online, the cost for each session will be \$150. For those attending in person, the cost for each session will be \$175 per person, which includes lunch for the five days.
