Friday, April 10 is not a day of abstinence! All Fridays of the year, unless they are Solemnities, are days of abstinence from meat or some other penance. Every day of the Easter Octave is a Solemnity.

(Days on the Church calendar have rankings, from top to bottom: Solemnity, Feast, Memorial, Optional Memorial. Feasts add a Gloria to the Mass; Solemnities generally add the Gloria and the Creed, plus having three readings like a Sunday Mass. There are also changes to the Divine Office for Feasts and Solemnities. Also during the Easter Season, the first reading at Mass is generally taken from the Acts of the Apostles rather than from the Old Testament.

SURREXIT DOMINUS VERE, ALLELUIA!

The Lord is truly risen. In some Catholic cultures, the customary way to greet someone during this Easter season is with the joyful acclamation, "Christ is risen!" The response is, "He is risen indeed!" The Fathers and Brothers of the Oratory wish all of you Easter joy that lasts throughout the season, your life, and eternity. Jesus Christ has given His life to free us from our sins, and risen to give us new life.
