ORATORY CORNER

"I was brought up from a child to take great delight in reading the Bible; but I had no formed religious convictions till I was fifteen. Of course, I had perfect knowledge of my Catechism" (*Apologia pro vita sua*, ch 1). These words of St John Henry Newman the second founder of the Oratory are how he begins his autobiography. When he was 63, Newman was accused of being a profoundly untruthful person. He was accused, by a leading Englishman, of being a liar. He was accused of being part of a Church that approved lying in order to win converts. He was accused of secretly being a Catholic for many years while officially being an Anglican. He was accused of being a religious double-agent, that is, staying as an Anglican in order to help people leave the Anglican Church and become Catholic.

St John Henry thought long and hard what to do. When this man, Charles Kingsley, would not retract, but reiterated his charges, Newman realized what he should do. He had to write a history of his religious opinions. He had to bring out his own mind and show in a living way that he was truthful. St John Henry, pray for us to love the truth more and more. Pray for us to know ourselves this Lent.


