IRAQI CHRISTIAN REFUGEE UPDATE

We now have a family assigned to us, which includes Melad Gorgees, 30, mother of two children; Stafia, age 13, and Stafro, age 10. Melad and her children left Iraq in 2003, fearing for their safety, due to the escalating sectarian violence and her extended family's employment assisting the US Army. They have been living in a Syrian refugee camp, waiting to for sponsorship to Canada or the US. When protest and violence broke out earlier this year in Syria, the family moved to Jordan. Melad has been supporting her family by working odd jobs wherever she can. We are told that they will probably not arrive until the fall of 2012. As their arrival date approaches, we will be asking parishioners to volunteer their time and material resources to help the family to settle.
