ST ANDRE BESSETTE



The Holy Cross brother known as "Frere Andre" is known to have cured thousands. At the age of 12, he was orphaned. He was not successful in any of the many trades he tried. He could barely read or write and was

sickly most of the time. At 15, he became a Brother of the Holy Cross and was the porter of the College of Notre Dame. He performed humble tasks for forty years and entrusted the the poor and sick who flocked to his cell to the care of St Joseph. He is the founder of St Joseph Oratory in Montreal. It was estimated there were nearly a million people who came to the Oratory to pay their last respects after his death in 1937. He was beatified in 1982 by Pope John Paul II and canonized on October 17, 2010 by Pope Benedict XVI. His feast day is January 6.

A NEW SAINT FOR THE ORATORY

Pope Francis has announced that Blessed Joseph Vaz of the Oratory, the Apostle of Sri Lanka, will be canonized a saint on January 14, 2015 during his visit to the island. Joseph Vaz was born in Goa, India, in 1651. He was ordained a priest of the Archdiocese of Goa in 1676. In 1685, he joined a group of priests hoping to live as a community, and helped form it into a congregation of the Oratory of St Philip Neri. This first congregation of native Indian priests became the source of missionaries to Sri Lanka. Fr Vaz volunteered to work there despite persecution of Catholics by Dutch colonial rulers. Priests were not permitted to preach under pain of imprisonment and death. He went to the island disguised as a labourer, searching for Catholics to administer his priestly duties to the faithful. He renewed the faith of the Sri Lankan Church and also made many converts to Christianity. In 1693, Bl Joseph worked a miracle of rain during a drought, after which the King of Kandy granted him protection and the freedom to preach the Gospel. During an epidemic in Kandy, when many fled, Fr Vaz stayed and ministered to the sick and dying. Bl Joseph Vaz died in 1711, after twenty-three years of arduous missionary work in Sri Lanka. Pope John Paul II beatified him on January 21, 1995 during his visit to Sri Lanka. His feast day is January 16. There will be a sung Mass at Holy Family Church at 5:30 p.m. on that day.


