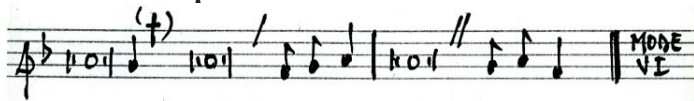

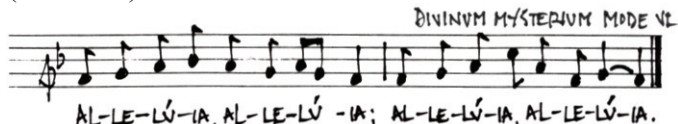

ORATORY CORNER

Newman in a Nutshell 5.0

St John Henry Newman, the newest doctor of the Church and the English Oratory founder, studied as an undergrad at Trinity College, Oxford University. He developed a reputation as their most brilliant and promising scholar. He loved the university life. He imagined that he would always be connected to the Colleges. But the Lord led him “by a different way.”

When he was a later a fellow, a don, at Oriel College, he wrote a poem about a flower, “Snapdragon.” Almost twenty years later, after he was a Catholic and forced to leave Oxford for the last time, he recalled this flower. “There used to be much snapdragon growing on the walls opposite my freshman's rooms there, and I had for years taken it as the emblem of my own perpetual residence even unto death in my University.” The snapdragon clung to the falls. It lived in the mortar of the buildings. It seemed like it could not be uprooted from the college. But Newman himself, contrary to his earlier ideas, was uprooted. The Lord led him by another route.

On this Epiphany Sunday, let us give thanks for how the Lord led Newman to the Catholic faith. He has been the instrument of many others, including those in our church today, into the “one true fold of the Redeemer.” Here in the Church we meet the One the Magi met. Here He transforms us. We cannot go home the same way we came to Him. Like the Magi, we too must go home “by a different route.” He changes us. He makes us like Himself!
