It's a good reminder to us to avail ourselves of God's great mercy in this sacrament. The Catechism of the Catholic Church has a wonderful quotation from St Augustine: "Whoever confesses his sins... is already working with God. God indicts your sins; if you also indict them, you are joined with God."

In other words, sin involves turning away from God. When we acknowledge and repent of our sins, we are on the same page with Him again. If we accuse ourselves of our sins now, the Adversary will not be able to accuse us of them at the hour of our death.

Speaking of St Vincent, of course he does not need to be cleaned up on the inside, but it is clear that his statue needs some work on the outside. Stay tuned for news of his return and that of his friends St Joseph, St Anthony and St Therese.
