CAN I RECEIVE COMMUNION IN A PROTESTANT CHURCH?

Catholics are not allowed to receive communion in Protestant churches and communities. This is because of the requirement that Catholics receive Communion only in churches whose sacraments are valid, and only from a validly ordained member of the clergy.

While there are some instances where Catholics can receive communion in Orthodox churches, because their orders and sacraments are valid, for a Catholic to receive communion in a Protestant service would be to give the impression that there is no difference between

their belief and Catholic belief in the Real Presence.

Protestants do not believe that the bread and wine really become the Body and Blood of Christ through the action of the priest, but only symbolically or representationally.

We must all pray for Christian unity, and "have a burning desire to join in celebrating the one Eucharist of the Lord" as Pope John Paul put it. I suppose that this is like the burning (chaste) desire of an engaged couple to consummate their marriage: it is still true that only when they are truly one in body and soul through the Sacrament of Matrimony is it legitimate and holy to do so. Let us all pray *That All May Be One*.

St. Anthony Zaccaria, f.d. July 5

At the same time that Martin Luther was staging his protest against the Church, another reformation within the Church was already underway. Among the early movers of the Counter-Reformation was Anthony Zaccaria.

Born to a patrician family, his father died when Anthony was two, and his mother, widowed at age 18, devoted herself to her son. He studied medicine at Padua, receiving his doctorate at age 22. Working as a physician to the poor in Cremona, Italy, he felt called to the religious life. He bequeathed his inheritance to his mother, worked as a catechist, and was ordained at age 26; legend says that angels were seen around the altar at his first Mass.

Anthony was a noted preacher and an excellent administrator. In Milan he established three congregations including the Society of Clerics of Saint Paul (the Barnabites) for men religious, the Angelics of Saint Paul for uncloistered nuns, and an association for married couples. Under his direction these groups helped reform the morals of the faithful, encouraged laymen to work together with the apostolate, and promoted the frequent reception of Communion and the Forty Hours' Devotion.

Anthony's holiness moved many to reform their lives but, as with all saints, it also moved many to oppose him. Twice his community had to undergo official religious investigation, and twice it was exonerated. While on a peace mission, Anthony became ill and died at age 36 at his mother's house; tradition says that in his last moments he had a vision of Saint Paul the Apostle.




