PILGRIMAGE TO MARTYRS' SHRINE – AUGUST 6 - 11

This is a walking pilgrimage for youth, open to boys and girls going to grade 9 and older. It will be supervised by Fr. Martin Hilbert and several adult helpers. Meet at Holy Family for Mass on Monday, August 6 at 8:30 a.m. Breakfast will be provided in the parish hall afer Mass. We ill then drive to Colgan, Ontario, where we will begin to walk, till we arrive at Midland on Friday, August 10. We stay overnight at Martyrs' Shrine and ride back to Toronto the afternoon of August 11. the total walking distance is 110 km, mostly along cycling and snowmobile trails and roads free of traffic. Sleeping accommodations will be in parish halls and tents on parish grounds - modesty and privacy being preserved between facilities for boy and girls.

<u>What NOT to Bring:</u> Electronic gadgets (cell/smart phones, games, MP3 players, etc.). The only exception is cameras.

Pilgrims will need to carry their belongings, at least part of the way, so pack lightly. Soap, shampoo, toothpaste, sunscreen, mosquito spray will be provided.

<u>Cost:</u> \$60/pilgrim (if cheques, payable to Fr. Martin Hilbert)
