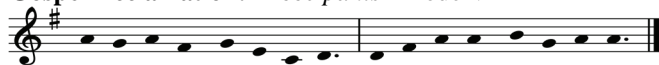

O memorial of the Lord’s Death! Living bread, granting life to man! Grant to me always to live from thee and that thou may always taste sweet to me.

ORATORY SUMMER SCHOOL

Registration for the annual Oratory Summer School has opened. There are two sessions available, each with 3 lectures per day.

- Second Session (July 13 to 17) **THE LIFE AND LEGACY OF SAINT FRANCIS OF ASSISI**

The Church has proclaimed 2026 as a Jubilee Year in honour of the 800th anniversary of the death of St. Francis of Assisi. His personal conversion did more than turn a wealthy young nobleman into *il poverello*, a simple and devout saint who renounced his earthly possessions. He was God's instrument to refocus the Church upon the simplicity of the Gospel message. The drama of his life and message has inspired the imagination of artists, poets, and filmmakers, and the admiration of innumerable people, both inside and outside the Church. He lives on most especially in those men and women who have chosen to follow his way of poverty and service. The Church has been enriched by his poverty. The cost for each session, which includes lunch each day for those attending in person, is \$200 per person. NEWMAN CORNER

A few years ago, in a pilgrimage to Montreal, some parishioners stayed at the John XXIII hotel at St Joseph's Oratory. The former convent has a chapel with the Blessed Sacrament reserved. Many pilgrims had never stayed in a building with a Tabernacle present. Being so close to the Eucharist was a profound consolation to these pilgrims. St John Henry Newman had a similar experience after he became a Catholic and was living at Maryvale. In a letter, he says, "*It is such an incomprehensible blessing to have Christ in bodily presence in one's house, within one's walls, as swallows up all other privileges ... To know that He is close by – to be able again and again through the day to go in to Him...*"

On this Sunday dedicated to the gift of the Eucharist, let us pray for a reawakening in our hearts of Eucharistic amazement. In another letter, Newman explains to a non-Catholic woman who is considering becoming Catholic: "*I was thinking of you this morning, when I said Mass. Oh that you were safe in the True Fold. I think you will be one day. You will then have the blessedness of seeing God face to face. You will have the blessedness of finding when you enter a Church, a Treasure Unutterable, the Presence of the Eternal Word Incarnate, the Wisdom of the Father who, even when He had done His work, would not leave us, but rejoices still to humble Himself by abiding in places on earth, for our sakes, while He reigns not the less on the right hand of God.*"

In a sermon of 1858, Newman said: "*He is not past, He is present now. And though He is not seen, He is here. The same God who walked the water, who did miracles, etc., is in the Tabernacle. We come before Him, we speak to Him just as He was spoken to ... years ago.*"

When he was over 80 years old, Newman spoke about praying with Our Lord for half an hour: "*We have a more wonderful, soothing time of silence than the Quakers. It is the silent half hour, spent, solus cum solo [alone with the Alone], before the Tabernacle.*" How blessed we are to have our church and the Tabernacle!
