

The Church never dissociates St Joseph from Jesus and Mary, and the Gospel of his feast mentions them together. St Joseph, humbly and faithfully fulfilling his noble and delicate task of caring for the Holy Family of Nazareth, is our model for the virtues of family life and daily duty, and the protector of purity and Christian home.

JUBILEE YEAR CORNER

We have looked at all the ways to gain a special plenary indulgence in this Jubilee of Hope, this Holy Year of 2025. While the Holy Year has many ways to gain indulgences, we cannot forget that the original idea of the Holy Year in 1300 was to call people to visit Rome. Rome is where St Peter went. Rome is where St Peter died. Rome is also where St Paul died.

Why did St Peter go to Rome? He did not leave us his reasons in writing. But one reason is shown to us by the Acts of the Apostles. Acts begins with Christ sending the Holy Spirit on Mary and the Apostles and 100 other disciples. On that day, Peter and the Apostles spoke about the great things God had done in Christ Jesus. People from all over the world were there. Twelve nations are mentioned. They all heard the preaching in their own languages. Cut to the heart, they asked Peter what they must do. "Repent, and be baptized, everyone of you, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit," Peter said. That day 3,000 people were added to the Church. The Church was, from the beginning, a universal phenomenon. She was "of the whole" world. She had all the nations included in her mystery.

But Rome was the capitol of the Roman empire. Rome was the symbol of all the pagan nations with all their gods, philosophy, and culture. For Peter to go to Rome and establish his authority there was to show the world that the Church was for all nations. Rome was the place where the Jews and Gentiles came together as one Church. We are Roman Catholics. We are not ashamed. By going to Rome, Peter taught us about the universality of the Church. The Church is God's family on earth. The Acts of the Apostles ends abruptly in Rome. The Church began in Jerusalem. But Peter brought the Church to Rome. Rome is the spiritual fulfilment of Jerusalem. Rome is the centre of God's household on earth. In Lent, "let us do good to all men, especially those of the household of faith." (Gal 6:10).
