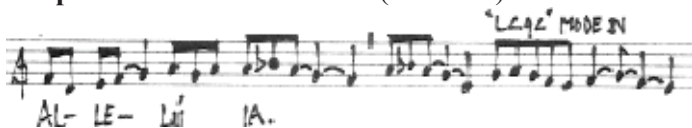

## JUBILEE YEAR CORNER

### Formation Ways to Get Indulgences in Jubilee

The principal way to gain Jubilee indulgences in the Holy Year of 2025 is through pilgrimages.

- Pilgrimages to Sacred Sites (Rome, Holy Land, 12 local churches in Toronto).
- Pilgrimage to Christ in those in need (in body or in soul) by corporal or spiritual works of mercy.

The second main way is by taking more seriously one's Christian formation.

"In addition, the faithful will be able to obtain the Jubilee Indulgence if, with a devout spirit, they participate

- 1.in popular missions, spiritual exercises,
- 2.or formation activities on the documents of the Second Vatican Council
- 3.and formation activities on the Catechism of the Catholic Church, held in a church or other suitable place, according to the mind of the Holy Father."

Are there opportunities for these three things close to St Vincent de Paul? Yes. St Vincent de Paul parish is spiritually joined to the Oratory of St Philip Neri, a community of priests and brothers who have been in Canada for 49.5 years! Many opportunities are available to us because of these sons of St Philip Neri who care for our historic parish. The Oratory is at 1372 King Street West, next to Holy Family Church. For more information on Oratorian events, contact: [mail@oratory-toronto.org](mailto:mail@oratory-toronto.org). Here are a few things to keep in mind.

**1. March 8 – Lenten Day of Recollection – 10am-3pm.** This annual event on the first Saturday of Lent is for everyone. There are talks for adults, kids, and teenagers. There is lunch and a Mass. We have the Stations of the Cross and Benediction. = popular missions, spiritual exercises.

**2. Twice a month on Wednesdays, 7:30-9:30pm – men's meetings – "Little Oratory."** This brotherhood is working through the documents of Vatican II. = formation activities on the documents of the Second Vatican Council

**3. Annual Summer School of Theology – July 7-11 and 14-18.** The first session covers the whole Catechism of the Catholic Church in 15 lectures. Perfect for those wanting an introduction to the Catholic faith. But we also have classes every Monday night at 7:30pm. = formation activities on the Catechism of the Catholic Church
