

50th Anniversary -- Oratory Corner

Why is St Philip Neri's image placed below the statue of Mary? In 2022, for the 400th anniversary of the canonization of St Philip, the Pope encouraged all churches run by the Oratorians to display relics of St Philip. Pope Francis offered plenary indulgences to those who made pilgrimages to visit the Apostle of Rome. The space below Our Lady provided a very handsome spot for a small image of St Philip. But such a placement is fitting given St Philip's love for Mary. When he built the Chiesa Nuova, the new Church, as the Romans called it, he wanted an image of Mary in every chapel. When he heard people calling him the founder of the Congregation of the Oratory, he would correct people. "Our Lady is the true foundress," he would say. When he was close to death on one occasion and the doctors had given up hope of his recovery, Our Lady appeared to him and cured him instantaneously. The Madonna, Mama Mia, has healed me, he told his physicians. When we visit the altar of Our Lady on this Mother's Day Weekend, we can ask St Philip to pray with us the prayer he loved to say: "Virgin Mary, Mother of God, pray to Jesus for me."

Mass for Fr Robinson and Oratory Picnic --

Saturday, June 7

As part of the Oratory's 50th anniversary celebrations, we will celebrate a Mass at the grave of Fr Robinson near Orangeville at 10:30 am. Afterwards, there will be a picnic at the Island Lake Conservation Area. The Oratory will provide a free BBQ lunch, but people are welcome to bring their own food and even share it if they are so inclined.
