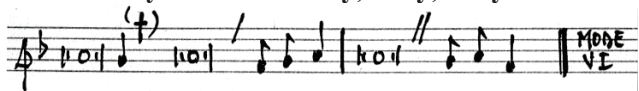

*How is the Holy Trinity the model for human communities?* The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* (CCC) 1877-8 explains: “The vocation of humanity is to show forth the image of God and to be transformed into the image of the Father's only Son. ### ORATORY SUMMER SCHOOL

Registration for the annual Oratory Summer School has opened. There are two sessions available, each with 3 lectures per day.

- 1st Session (July 6 to 10): systematic introduction to *The Catechism of The Catholic Church*.
- Second Session (July 13 to 17) **THE LIFE AND LEGACY OF SAINT FRANCIS OF ASSISI**

The Church has proclaimed 2026 as a Jubilee Year in honour of the 800th anniversary of the death of St. Francis of Assisi. His personal conversion did more than turn a wealthy young nobleman into *il poverello*, a simple and devout saint who renounced his earthly possessions. He was God's instrument to refocus the Church upon the simplicity of the Gospel message. The drama of his life and message has inspired the imagination of artists, poets, and filmmakers, and the admiration of innumerable people, both inside and outside the Church. He lives on most especially in those men and women who have chosen to follow his way of poverty and service. The Church has been enriched by his poverty. The cost for each session, which includes lunch each day for those attending in person, is \$200 per person. ### NEWMAN CORNER

The Sunday after Pentecost is dedicated to the most Holy Trinity. With the sending of the Holy Spirit, God's innermost secret is fully revealed. He is a community of Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. What are the main truths about the dogma of the Trinity? According to St John Henry Newman dogma consists of 9 propositions:

1. *There are Three who give testimony in heaven, the Father, the Word or Son, and the Holy Spirit.*
2. *From the Father is, and ever has been, the Son.*
3. *From the Father and Son is, and ever has been, the Spirit.*
4. *The Father is the One Eternal Personal God.*
5. *The Son is the One Eternal Personal God.*
6. *The Spirit is the One Eternal Personal God.*
7. *The Father is not the Son.*
8. *The Son is not the Holy Ghost.*
9. *The Holy Ghost is not the Father.*

Newman adds: “Now I think it is a fact, that, whereas these nine propositions contain the Mystery, yet, taken, not as a whole, *but separately, each by itself*, they are not only apprehensible, but admit of a real apprehension.” Today let us focus on each of these truths individually. The Trinity is not just a mystery to study! We really can know each of the divine Persons!
