#### SOME LITURGICAL CHANGES – COMING DECEMBER 2

Beginning the first Sunday of Advent the 11:30 Solemn High Mass (Usus antiquior) will no longer be celebrated at St. Vincent's but at Holy Family Church on King St. at 11:00 a.m., replacing the Sung Latin Mass (Novus Ordo). In accordance with this Philip Fournier, currently organist and choir director at SVP, will become organist and choir director at Holy Family Church. The Oratory Children's Choir will remain under Mr. Fournier's direction and return to its original home at Holy Family. Peter Bishop, presently in charge of music at Holy Family, will become the organist and choir director at St. Vincent de Paul. There will be some adjustments to the Mass schedule at St. Vincent de Paul: a sung English Mass in the new rite at 11:30 a.m., which we hope will be a more convenient time for families with children. The 9:30 Mass will become a Low mass in Latin (Usus antiquior).

#### PLENARY INDULGENCE IN NOVEMBER



A plenary indulgence, to be applied to the souls of the faithful departed, can be gained by a visit to a cemetery from **November 1 to 8** (inclusive) to pray for the

dead, under the usual conditions, which are:

- Going to confession within 7 days (before or after) of performing the indulgenced act.
- Receiving Communion within 7 days of performing the indulgenced act.
- Prayer for the Pope's intentions.
- Detachment from sin, even venial sin, while performing the act. To the extent that one's detachment is not perfect, the plenary indulgence becomes a partial indulgence.
