

Trivia – St Vincent de Paul's Life and Times:

Between 1633-1660, St Vincent de Paul gave spiritual conferences to the Daughters of Charity, the female religious order he and St Louis de Marillac founded. These sisters carried out heroic work amongst the poor and needy. 120 of these conferences have survived because of notes taken by the sisters. They wanted the words of St Vincent to survive. The final conference took place six months after St Louise died and it was called "the Virtues of Louise de Marillac." Not long after this final conference, St Vincent de Paul passed into eternal life.

Wisdom from St Vincent de Paul:

"Prudence consists in seeing the means, the times, and the places when we should give admonitions and also how we should comport ourselves in all circumstances."
