### ST CECILIA - PRAY FOR US



St Cecilia is one of the most popular Roman saints. Her birth is unknown but it is believed she died in 177A.D. According to the legend of her life, she was a native of Rome from a good family educated and practiced in the Christian religion. She was compelled to marry even though she made a vow of virginity to God. On the night of the wedding, St Cecilia was able not only to convince her husband, Valerian to let her remain a virgin but also to convert him to Christianity. She also converted his brother, Tiburtius. Both were great defenders of the faith and were beheaded. She, too was captured and was sentenced to death by suffocation but survived. Beheading was ordered but this was a failed attempt. She lay in pain, for three days all the while singing songs of praise to God and comforting herself with sacred music and never ceasing to preach about God. Her grave was discovered in 817 and the body was moved to the church of Saint Cecilia in Rome. The tomb was opened and her body was found incorrupt in 1599. She is the first saint to be incorrupt. Her feast day is November 22. St Cecilia is the patron saint of music – a good reason why we will have our Ceili on her feast day.
