#### BILL C6 (WAS BILL C8)

The bill is ostensibly about prohibiting "conversion therapy", which should be prohibited if it means coercive actions against people's wills or degrading "therapies". But the language of the bill is dangerous, for, as it stands it could be used to prosecute parents or priests who counsel chastity and speak about God's gift of sexuality as the Church understands it, or to shut down groups such as Courage, which help people with same sex attraction to live authentic Christian lives. The proponents of the bill in their various propaganda say that C6 is not aimed against parents, priests, and other counselors, but it is the language of the bill as passed and not the smooth talk around it that will be the basis of its application. #### PLENARY INDULGENCE IN NOVEMBER

A plenary indulgence, to be applied to the souls of the faithful departed, can be gained by a visit to a cemetery from **November 1 to 8** (*inclusive*) to pray for the dead, under the usual conditions, which are:

- Going to confession within about 20 days (before or after) of performing the indulgenced act.
- Receiving Communion within 7 days of performing the indulgenced act.
- Prayer for the Pope's intentions.
- Detachment from sin, even venial sin, while performing the act. To the extent that one's detachment is not perfect, the plenary indulgence becomes a partial indulgence.

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May their souls and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.
