#### FEAST OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL, SEPTEMBER 27

Please note that there is an additional Mass on Tuesday evening at 8:00 p.m. in celebration of the feast of our patron. Also, the faithful have the opportunity for a plenary indulgence if they attend Mass at St. Vincent de Paul Church on his feast. The normal requirements set by the Church for plenary indulgences are that within several days before or after the visit to a church on the day of the patron's feast, the person participates in the Sacrament of Penance and receives the Holy Eucharist. On the day of the visit, the person is to pray for the intentions of the Holy Father, "by reciting one Our Father and one Hail Mary; nevertheless, the individual faithful are free to recite any other prayer according to their own piety and devotion toward the Supreme Pontiff".




