Ash Wednesday Masses with Distribution of Ashes THIS WEDNESDAY, MARCH 2, 2022 9:05 a.m. & 6:00 p.m. (Vietnamese Mass: 7:30 p.m.)

This is a universal day of fasting and of abstinence from meat. The law of abstinence from meat binds those who are 14 and older; the law of fasting binds those from 18 to 59 years of age. Parents and educators are reminded of their duty to introduce children gradually to the understanding and practice of penance.



COVID-19 GOVERNMENT RESTRICTION UPDATE

On February 14th, Ontario Premier Doug Ford announced that most of the provincial Covid-19 restrictions will be eliminated in two phases. The first phase of easing restrictions began on Thursday, February 17th and the second phase will begin on Tuesday, March 1st.
