

### WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY January 18-25, 2021



*"Abide in my love and  
you shall bear much fruit"  
(cf. John 15:5-9).*

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity in 2021 was prepared by the Monastic Community of Grandchamp. The Community is located in Areuse, in the Canton of Neuchâtel, Switzerland. The theme, taken from the 15th chapter of the Gospel of St. John, expresses Grandchamp Community's vocation to prayer, reconciliation and unity in the Church and the human family. The actual text of the theme, "Abide in my love... you shall bear much fruit", comes from a joining of phrases from John 15:9 and John 15:5. The entire pericope chosen by Grandchamp, the World Council of Churches and the Pontifical Council for Promoting Christian Unity, is John 15:1-17. Here, Jesus reminds his disciples that he is the vine and we are the branches. If we abide in him, in Jesus and the Covenant made in his precious blood, we will be such a healthy branch as to bear much fruit, abundant grapes.

Therefore, abiding in Christ's love, let us love one another. The events of Covid-19 and of 2020 in general were not foreseen in the planning at Grandchamp in September 2019. Human society is reminded that through the struggle of 2020 we are needier for love, fellowship and support than we have been in generations. So, let the sap flow! Let us bear much fruit.
