The Epiphany of The Lord (January 6th) celebrated this year on Sunday, January 4th is the 12th day of Christmas. The word 'epiphany' comes from the Greek word 'epiphainen' meaning 'shine upon', 'to manifest' or 'to make known'. Jesus was 'made known' to the gentiles for the first time with the visitation of the three Wise Men or Magi. In many parts of Europe, the exchanging of gifts occurs on the Epiphany; the day the gifts were presented to the baby Jesus by the visiting Magi.

Epiphany (per the Canadian Catholic Bishops) marks the end of the Christmas Season. However, Ordinary Time, does not begin until Monday, January 12th after the Baptism of the Lord celebration of Sunday, January 11th
