### Delegation To The Holy See

The Bishops of Canada, working with Indigenous people have, for over 2 years, been preparing a delegation of Indigenous people to meet with the Holy Father in 2021 to foster meaningful encounters of dialogue and healing. The delegation will include participation of a diverse group of Elders/Knowledge Keepers, residential school survivors and Indigenous youth. This event will be an opportunity for the Pope to hear directly from Indigenous Peoples, and address the impact of colonization and the implication of the Church in the residential schools so as to respond to the suffering of Indigenous Peoples and the ongoing effects of their trauma.
