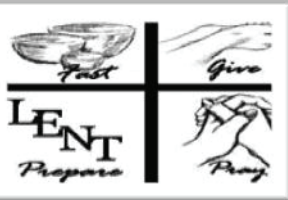
**SACRAMENT OF THE SICK:**
