

CLERGY APPOINMENT CHANGE

Fr. Peter Tran replaced Fr. Dominic Bui in August. Please say hello when you have the opportunity. Fr. Peter wrote a few words to introduce himself, shared below.



My name is Long Hien Tran. I was born in a small village in Northern Vietnam. After attending elementary school and graduating from high school, I moved to the South of Vietnam and studied at university, earning a BA in Business. From 2008 to 2011, I attended the vocation class of Bui Chu Diocese and studied as a seminarian at the Seminary of the Immaculate Conception Major Seminary in Bùi Chu. From 2017 to 2019, I traveled to the USA and lived at St. John Vianney Seminary, then moved to Canada to continue my studies in theology. From 2020 to 2023, I studied at St. Augustine's Seminary in Toronto, Canada. I completed the requirements for the Pontifical Baccalaureate of Sacred Theology and Master of Divinity (MDiv) degrees at St. Augustine's Seminary. From 2023 to 2025, I have been admitted to the Pontifical Licentiate in Theology and Patristic Studies (S.T.L.) degree program with a full scholarship. I was ordained a priest on October 6, 2024, for the Diocese of Bui Chu, Vietnam. His Eminence Frank Cardinal Leo, Metropolitan Archbishop of Toronto, has appointed me as an Associate Pastor to Reverend Joseph Tran, Pastor of St. Cecilia Parish, Toronto, with all faculties, duties, and rights accorded to an assistant priest under the law. My appointment became effective on August 1, 2025.
