# Sunday, April 2, 2023 Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord A message from Fr. Rob....



Today we begin this special week of prayer and reflection in preparation for the Resurrection of the Lord. Like the crowds in the Gospel, we want to follow Jesus and welcome Him into our hearts. The liturgies of this week are meant to help us grow in

our discipleship and re-commit ourselves to a life of loving service.

I invite and encourage all of us to stop, pause and pray this week. Remain close to the Lord as we make this journey with him. See inside for the times and details of our Triduum liturgies. We will gather together as one Family on Thursday at Our Lady of the Atonement for the Mass of the Lord's Last Supper. We give thanks for the gift of the Eucharist, the grace we receive in the Sacraments and again choose to follow the Lord in serving one another in love.

Good Friday will have two celebrations of the Solemn Passion of the Lord at both churches beginning at 3 pm.

The Easter Vigil will be held at St. John Vianney on Holy Saturday at 7 pm. Again we will gather together to welcome the Light of Christ. This most special liturgy reminds us of the importance of our baptism and the faithful love God has shown us all through salvation history.

A reminder of Easter Sunday: Our Lady of the Atonement at 8:30 am and 10:30 am; St. John Vianney at 9 am and 11 am.

Let us continue to pray for the children as they prepare to receive the Eucharist for the first time during the Easter Season.

We adore you O Christ and we praise you, because by Your Holy Cross You have redeemed the world.



#### **NURSING HOME MINISTRY MEETING**

After a very long time we are in the process of being able to resume our pastoral outreach to the three nursing homes in our area: Riverside Place (1st Tuesday), Heron Terrace (2nd Tuesday) and Aspen Lake (4th Tuesday) all at 2 pm. We met with our 3 contacts from the homes and are working on a process to get back for mass in May. In order to do this, we want to have a meeting with those interested in serving as volunteers and go over some of the protocols that are in place: required vaccinations, updated police check, Covid test upon arrival at the home etc. Please mark your calendars and plan to join us for this important training session on Thursday, April 20th at 1 pm in St. Francis Hall at Our Lady of the Atonement church. Robin (ext. 21) can assist you with the process required to obtain a Police Check. In many cases because of the time period, many of the records will have expired and a new records check will be required. Due to some of the nursing home protocols we will not require as many volunteers present per mass so this will be a great help to us as many of our volunteers are no longer able to assist.
