Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time & Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary August 8 & 15th, 2021 A Message From Fr. Rob

PLEASE NOTE: This is a two week bulletin!

We continue our reflection on Chapter 6 of St. John's Gospel, the Bread of Life discourse. We hear about the strength that is given to us in the Eucharist. Elijah was exhausted from his struggles with the unfaithful leaders of Israel. Having been chased into the desert, he is discouraged, frustrated and afraid. The Lord sends an angel to him to provide for his needs and to give him strength to continue his journey to the mountain to speak with God. Like Elijah we too face struggles, frustrations and discouragement. It is in Jesus, the Bread of Life that we are strengthened. Jesus tells us that unless we believe in Him and the gift He offers. we will not have life. Let us take time to reflect on how the Eucharist helps us on our journey.

We pray for the children preparing to receive the Eucharist for the first time soon. May they always treasure this gift.

This special solemnity on Sunday, August 15th reminds us that God has a plan for each of us for eternity. Through the power of the Resurrection, Mary shares in the Divine life of Jesus and is spared the corruption that comes with death. She is brought into the glory of heaven to be with the Lord forever. We too will die but our faith in Jesus the Risen Lord assures us that there is a place prepared for us in the Kingdom when we are called home. Mary from her place in heaven intercedes for us so that we might keep our eyes on Christ, the Risen Lord.
