A Message From Fr. Rob....***

**PLEASE NOTE:** This is a two week bulletin!

It is fitting that our celebrations of First Communion have coincided with the weeks dedicated to Chapter 6 of St. John's Gospel-the Bread of Life discourse. We have reflected on just how essential the Eucharist is for our journey as disciples. Just as the children have realized that Jesus offers this gift to them to help them to grow as disciples, so too we need the Eucharist if we are truly going to embrace a life of holiness. But the choice is ours. Jesus freely invites us to the banquet but He does not force us. We must willingly choose to embrace the Gospel and realize the importance of the Eucharist in our spiritual lives.

In the Gospel, some in the crowd walked away from Jesus and the life of discipleship because they felt it was too demanding. Indeed it is very demanding but the Lord also offers us the grace we need to walk this journey of faith with Him in trust.

While some protocols are being relaxed, we all must do our part to ensure we stay safe: masks must be worn in church at all times, physical distancing must be maintained, sanitizer units have been placed near entrances and in other areas for your personal use. Ushers will not be doing it at the doors any longer.

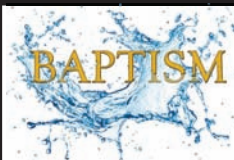

**Adherence to COVID-19 Protocols**

We appreciate everyone's patience and understanding as we continue to follow the provincial protocols required for us to be open. Masses have been at capacity every week. We cannot increase capacity because we are required to maintain physical distancing -6 feet throughout the church. This means we are only allowed in a specific number of people at each mass. As most of our people come as singles, this really limits the space. You must call in for mass each week (Tuesday-Thursday 9 am to 3 pm.) We are required to keep the name and contact number of each person/family group for contact tracing. Masks must be worn at all times in the church.

Some protocols have been relaxed: we no longer have to clean pews after each mass and now as you enter, you will see sanitizer units on the church walls which you are asked to use personally rather than at the door from an usher. Each person is also required to do a self-screening before coming to church. We all have a part to play in ensuring the safety of each other.
