# Sunday, December 10, 2023 Second Sunday of Advent A Message from Fr. Rob

On this second Sunday of Advent our Gospel presents us with the figure of John The Baptist, the last of the prophets whose task it was to prepare the people of Israel for the immediate arrival of the Messiah. Notice how St. Mark's Gospel begins today: "The beginning of the good news of Jesus Christ, the Son of God." St. Mark wastes no time in pointing out that #1 Jesus is the Son of God and #2 He has come to bring good news.

The role of John the Baptist was to call the people to a new awareness and to change their ways, returning to the Lord in order to best welcome the Messiah.

During this Advent Season we too have an opportunity for change and renewal as we prepare for the Lord's coming in our lives. We are invited to trust in God's grace and allow the Holy Spirit to guide us.

Speaking of the Holy Spirit, we will celebrate next Sunday with our youth and their families as they receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. It is always a moment of joy to see our young people growing in their faith. Let us continue to encourage them with our prayers and our witness of faith.
