Sunday, February 19, 2023 Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time A message from Fr. Rob....

Over the last few weeks we have listened to the words of Jesus in the Sermon on the Mount. Today on this last Sunday before we begin the Season of Lent, our readings once again push the boundaries of our discipleship. I recall that when visiting the Gr. 12 classes at St. Joseph's High School to talk about moral issues, I would begin by writing the word "respect" on the board. This is at the heart of our readings today. St. Paul reminds us that we are the dwelling place of the Holy Spirit. We are to reverence the presence of God in each person. Moses recounts in the Leviticus version of the 10 Commandments our starting point: "You shall be holy for the Lord is holy." Our discipleship is all about growing in holiness.

The journey we are about to embark upon for Lent is one in which we are desiring to grow in holiness. Jesus demands we go further. He challenges us today to embrace respect, reverence and reconciliation. Our world is in dire need of all three of these things. There is war, conflict, misunderstanding, prejudice, nastiness, mistrust and the list goes on. Again we are invited to be salt for the earth and light for the world.

May we pray for one another as we begin this journey on Wednesday. Take note of the numerous masses being offered on that day. It is a day of fasting and abstinence as we call upon the Lord for the grace of conversion. We have included the insert of our Lenten program again so keep it handy.
