Sunday, February 4, 2024 Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Both Job and St. Paul speak of the challenges of living as a child of God in the world. They recognize that each day brings blessings as well as obstacles and distractions that can weigh one down. In Job's case, he eventually figures out that despite all the misfortune that befalls him, God has never left his side. God has been his source of strength. St. Paul sees that discipleship comes with a heavy price and the Gospel of Jesus is not something that he can run away from but must embrace fully as a means of support.

Jesus continues to show the core of His mission in today's Gospel: healing. His first response when encountering people with their heavy burdens and weaknesses is to bring them peace. But Jesus also knows the foundation of His mission: prayer. Notice that He slips away and finds a quiet spot to spend time in prayer to His Father. What an important signal for us! The demands of life, family, work, community can only be met if we are immersed in a life of prayer, of opening ourselves up to God and the gift of grace.
