One of the things we notice immediately about Jesus is His complete dedication to the mission entrusted to Him by the Father. He is constantly about the work of healing, comforting and reconciling. St. Paul in our second reading speaks of the commission given to him as he says "woe to me if I do not proclaim the Gospel". He understands what it means to be a servant of the Good News. Such determination in both of them is our inspiration.

The grace of our baptism is such that each one of us has become a messenger of the Gospel of Jesus. It is not something we can shy away from or even take lightly. It is an awesome responsibility because the God news brings life, peace and joy.
