Sunday, February 9, 2025 Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time From Fr. Rob.....



Our second reading today from St. Paul contains what is called the kerygma-the core teaching of our faith. Paul proclaims that it is this teaching which was handed down to him. He in turn passed it on to others and so it has been for over 2000 years. Every Sunday, we proclaim that Christ died for our sins, that He was buried, then rose from the dead and then appeared to His disciples. That is why we profess the Creed each Sunday. It is a formal proclamation of what we believe (and in whom we believe).

The Mission of Jesus was an inclusive one. He set about meeting people in the very ordinary circumstances of their lives and shared the Good News. He helped them to become aware of God's grace working all around them. Even though the fisherman have worked all night and caught nothing, they do what Jesus asks and let down the nets again. And they are rewarded for their trust and amazed at the catch. Jesus is inviting us to trust Him at all times and open our eyes to the many signs of grace.

To be a disciple is to live the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Christ each day and by word and deed, bring the Risen Lord to those we encounter.

As part of the Jubilee of Hope we will offer occasional special masses to ask for God's blessings on our jubilee pilgrimage. Join us Monday, February 10th at 6:30 pm at St. John Vianney. The following day is the World Day of the Sick (Our Lady of Lourdes) so we will offer the Anointing of the Sick at this mass.
