Sunday, January 14, 2024 Second Sunday in Ordinary Time A Message from Fr. Rob

As we begin the Season of Ordinary Time, our scriptures focus on the importance of listening to God's call. Eli helps Samuel to listen and then to respond: "Speak Lord for your servant is listening." John the Baptist points out the Lamb of God and Andrew immediately goes to follow Jesus. His encounter with Jesus changes him and he brings his brother to meet Jesus. And the process continues with James and John and so on.

Pope Benedict liked to say that our faith is about an encounter, a relationship with Jesus. It is about taking the time to meet the Lord in prayer and allowing the encounter to transform us. The disciples show us the importance of an open heart in order to come and meet the Lord.

In this year of Prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood, we are being asked to encourage young men we see to answer God's call. We need to recognize the gifts that God has given to them and to invite them to consider a priestly vocation. Let us keep our eyes open and like Andrew invite these men to come and meet the Lord. More to come on this initiative next week.
